Full-time position beginning on September 1, 2017

We are seeking a qualified individual to fill the position of Assistant Professor in the field of Biological Psychology. The individual should possess knowledge of and a core interest in the neurobiological fundamentals of social interactions and their disorders, and be able to enrich our current research program.

In addition to the procedural hiring requirements for this position, we are seeking someone who has a record of academic excellence and obtains a doctorate (preferably in psychology or neuroscience) and who can also demonstrate thorough knowledge of and experience in neuroimaging (especially functional magnetic resonance imaging). We require a person with wide-ranging skills in neuroscientific data analysis as well as excellent knowledge of methodology and statistics. A particular interest in brain and hormone research (psychoneuroendocrinology) would be ideal in combination with innovative approaches (e.g., chemosensory research via olfactometry). The spectrum of methodologies used in our laboratory include psychophysiological, neuroimaging, biochemical, chemosensory, and molecular genetic approaches. Close cooperation is desired with our “Outpatient Clinic for Stress-Related Disorders” in the context of experimental psychopathology research. Postgraduate psychotherapy training can be completed at our state-accredited Freiburg Training Institute for Behavioral Therapy. We expect the appointee to instruct courses (Bachelor and Master curricula in psychology), to have published in international journals, and to have a proven track record of acquiring funding for research projects. The appointee will be working as central part of a highly motivated team and will be expected to significantly contribute to our research program.

The position is for three years initially, and may be extended for another three years. The salary paid will correspond to A13 (100%).

The University of Freiburg is striving to raise the number of female employees in the sciences and specifically encourages qualified women to apply. Individuals with disabilities will be shown preference in case of equal aptitude.
